Goal 1 Strengthen social care services and economic security for the disadvantaged

- Target 1.1 Enhance the self-support rate of the financially vulnerable.
- Target 1.2 Constantly promote social assistance to take care of lowincome households and middle-low-income households and to relieve those in need of emergency aid or disaster relief; and assist them in achieving self-sufficiency.
- Target 1.3 Optimize the coverage of all citizens, particularly the vulnerable, in the social insurance system, such as the Labor Insurance, the National Health Insurance, and National Pension Insurance; enrich the long-term care system; enhance resources deployment and service provision; and constantly provide living assistance for the senior citizens, children, and youth in the vulnerable group.
