Goal 1 Strengthen social care services and economic security for the disadvantaged

- Target 1.1 Enhance the self-support rate of the financially vulnerable.
- Target 1.2 Constantly promote social assistance to take care of low-income households and middle-low-income households and to relieve those in need of emergency aid or disaster relief; and assist them in achieving self-sufficiency.
- Target 1.3 Optimize the coverage of all citizens, particularly the vulnerable, in the social insurance system, such as the Labor Insurance, the National Health Insurance, and National Pension Insurance; enrich the long-term care system; enhance resources deployment and service provision; and constantly provide living assistance for the senior citizens, children, and youth in the vulnerable group.
- Target 1.4 Enhance the protection and equality of all citizens, particularly the vulnerable, those impaired, in starting business, employment, loan, financing, housing, and land ownership.
- Target 1.5 Reduce the losses caused by various disasters, and in particular, protect the vulnerable and the low-income groups.
- Target 1.a Expand the scale of the plans to promote employment and to end poverty for low-income households and middle-low-income households.

- Target 2.1 Ensure all nationals have access to safe, nutritious and sufficient food.
- Target 2.2 Address the nutritional needs of at all stages in the life cycle.
- Target 2.3 Raise agricultural productivity and incomes of farmers through providing secure and equal access to land, productive resources and inputs, knowledge, financial services, markets and value-adding mechanisms.
- Target 2.4 Ensure sustainable food production systems and implement agricultural practices that are resilient to climate change by progressively improving land and soil quality, maintaining ecosystems, and enhancing the qualities of agricultural production.

- Target 4.1 Ensure that all girls and boys by the age of 15 complete free, equitable, and quality basic compulsory education leading to relevant and effective learning outcomes.
- Target 4.2 Provide communities with new types of public educare services, expand the convenience and accessibility of public educare, Increase the opportunities for children to enter kindergarten, and ensure and assist children in accepting educare services.
- Target 4.3 Ensure all youth and adults have opportunities to accept equal, affordable and quality higher education.
- Target 4.4 Enhance youth's obtainment of information and communications technology (ICT) skills, and increase the opportunities of youth to gain relevant professional techniques and vocational skills.
- Target 4.5 Ensure disadvantaged groups obtain education at all levels as well as vocational training, including persons with physical or mental disabilities, indigenous peoples, and disadvantaged children.

by increasing teachers' knowledge of the aforementioned topics, and accelerate paths for students to participate in public affairs. Establish professional qualified educational environments and facilities, continuously promote policies related to various cultures, diverse development, and cultural accessibility to ensure students master the required knowledge and skills of sustainable development promotion.

Target 4.a Establish and enhance the Internet information environment in primary schools, junior high schools, and senior high schools, and provide students with physical or mental disabilities with the required facilities to provide efficient learning.

Target 4.b In order to enhance the education quality and to increase the number of qualified teachers, the amount of teachers who participate in teacher cultivation is maintained every year.

- Target 5.1 Reduce the sex ratio at birth.
- Target 5.2 Reduce the proportion of women subjected to physical, sexual or psychological violence by a current or former intimate partner in the previous 12 months.

- Target 6.1 Supply adequate quantity of quality water and tap water to achieve water safety.
- Target 6.2 Achieve public toilet cleaning management to enhance the proportion of public toilets with "distinction" in the evaluation to over 80%.
- Target 6.3 Improve the living hygiene of citizens by optimizing river water quality; enhance the implementation of sewage and wastewater treatment; enhance water reusability and reduce the demand for tradition resources development through the innovative use of secondary effluents from public sewage treatment plants; tighten the audit and control of industrial wastewater discharge and track down suspicious pollution sources to stop water quality pollution; optimize river water quality to protect the national health and maintain the ecosystem; and strengthen the chemical flow tracking to improve management performance.
- Target 6.4 Promote water conservation and enhance water efficiency to reduce substantial increase in average water consumption; encourage the water recycling rate of industrial park enterprises; enhance the process water recycling rate of science park enterprises; and ensure no substantial annual increase in freshwater withdrawals by enhancing water conservation and diversifying water sources, such as water reclamation and seawater desalination.
- Target 6.5 Implement integrated water resources management.
- Target 6.6 Constantly implement river integrated governance to

maintain environment landscaping and habitat building at the same time; maintain a weighted average Carlson trophic state index (CTSI) below 45, effective capacity of Taiwan's 20 major reservoirs; implement the periodic quality check of the quality of sediment of rivers, lakes, reservoirs, and irrigational channels across the country to progressively build the sediment quality database; accelerate polluted site improvement to ensure the sustainable use of soil and groundwater resources and protect public health; and encourage enterprises and groups to adopt coastal areas for enterprises to love Earth and fulfill their corporate social responsibility.

- Target 6.a Constantly assist developing countries in promoting plans to improve local water and sanitation conditions (same as Target 17.4).
- Target 6.b Constantly promote community participation and encourage citizens to report pollution, clean up mess, and implement river watch.
- Target 6.c Improve air quality to protect public health.
